ONLY BELIEVE

- Jesus lives to tell us that it is done – it is finished. The healing has already been given; we just need to believe the truth. Whatever the Lord has spoken, it is a done deal.
- The whole world is under the sway of the wicked one, but the Lord is telling us today that Jesus overcame the cross for us.
- Healing is ours. Believe that we are already healed.
- We celebrate the Resurrection Sunday because it is the day that Jesus rose from the dead. He defeated death, sickness, the devil, and the curse.
- *Tayong mga nananampalataya sa Kanya ay hindi na magpapadaya sa kaaway.* We know the truth: Jesus is alive forevermore.
- He is alive. He ministers to us; He gives us hope and a future.
- Jesus is risen. Nabuhay Siyang muli. He died, but on the third day, He rose again. **(1 Corinthians 15:20)**
- On a Sunday, Mary Magdalene saw that the stone of the tomb had been removed. She told Peter and John and they saw that the tomb was empty. **(John 20:1-10)**
- Mary saw Jesus. He told her to tell His brethren that He will ascend to His Father and your Father, His God and your God. **(John 20:11-18)**
- On the evening of that Sunday, Jesus came and showed Himself to the disciples. He stood in the midst of them, and breathed on them. **(John 20:19-23)**
- Every time we gather on the first day of the week (Sunday, the Lord's Day), He is in the midst of us. He wants us to receive peace, shalom, in every area of our lives.
- The disciples told Thomas, who was not with them that Sunday, that they have seen the Lord. He said that he will not believe it until he sees Him with his own eyes. The next Sunday, Jesus came and showed Himself to the disciples including Thomas and he believed. **(John 20:24-28)**
- Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed. **(John 20:29)**
- We, the believers of Christ, are blessed because we believe in Him though we have not yet seen Him. That is faith.
- These are written so that we may believe in Jesus and have life in His name. **(John 20:30-31)**
- We believe in Jesus and we have the life of Jesus in us. The same life of Jesus (which overcame the cross), we already have right now.
- And because we have the life of Jesus, we do not have to carry our burdens and problems. We cast our cares unto Him.
- We believe and we receive the healing. Healing is ours.

*As we believe in Jesus, we receive
His life in us.
He has conquered it all at the cross
for us – it is finished.
Live in this truth.
Whatever you need, believe, and receive
that you already have it in Jesus' name.
Believe and receive that salvation,
healing, financial provision, and freedom
are already ours!*
