SUKDULANG BIYAYA (PART 3) – YOU ARE SO GIFTED

- You are so gifted. The question is *na-unbox mo na ba?*
- You are so loved by God. *Bukod kay Kristo*, and also with Jesus, *ibinigay ng Diyos ang Kanyang sukdulang biyaya.*
- **1 Peter 5:1** – Jesus took all the sufferings so He can dispense grace upon grace.
- Gift – *charisma* in Greek – It is grace from God. A favour with which one receives without any merit of his own.
- *Ibinigay kasi mabuti ang Diyos. Siya ay nagmamahal sa ating lahat.*
- Be so conscious *na sobra-sobra ang biyaya ng Diyos sa ating buhay. Di mo pa hinihingi, naibigay na Niya.*
- You are already complete. Declare: “I am complete in Christ. *Walang kulang sa akin. Si Kristo ang aking kakumpletuhan.*”
- This makes you so confident it doesn’t matter what other people say.
- The Elders – An elder or leader or overseer watches over and cares for the church, a role they fulfill by teaching, praying, and setting a good example, these are all good works.
- *Wala ito sa edad.* Ex. Timothy – a young pastor.
- Who made you an elder? It is Christ in you. His Spirit leading us unto the good works prepared for us to walk in.
- We are God’s workmanship. Declare: “*Obra maestra ako.*”
- God is glorified when we bear much fruit when we do good works.
- Our gifts are free. *Tinatanggap lang ang regalo.*
- **Ephesians 1:3-6** – Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who:
 1. Has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, just as He
 2. chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be
 3. holy and
 4. without blame before Him in love,
 5. having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which
 6. He made us accepted in the Beloved.
- How He has blessed us with every spiritual blessing!
- **1 Corinthians 15:10** – We do not allow the grace of God to be in vain *sa buhay natin. Hindi natin hahayaan na masayang tulad ni Paul.*
- *Paano nasasayang? Pag hindi mo tinanggap o pinaniwalaan.*
- We need to receive it. Believe it is a gift for you and accept it by faith.
- Do not put your sin before you but put the grace of God before you.
- This gift is to the full measure of Jesus Christ. (To the max!)
- Gifts of Jesus Christ given to us:
- **1. Grace Gifts** – We lead in different ways according to the grace gifts we have received from God. *Ang importante ay we use them: Romans 12:4-8.*
- *Iba-iba ang purpose natin*, that’s how much we need each other with the grace gifts given to us.

- Each one needs each one: **Prophecy** – speaking about Jesus Christ; **Ministry** – with cheerfulness; **Teaching** – teach; **Exhorts** – encourage; **Gives** – with liberality; **Leads** – with diligence; **Mercy** – with cheerfulness.
- Use them. Use your own gift. That is your magnet to people. They will like you for what you are doing. Do not do what you are not gifted for.
- Each gift is equally important. Use it in full blast, *itodo mo na!* Jesus is seen in you when you use your grace gifts.
- **2. Fruit of the Spirit – Galatians 5:22-23**
- The Holy Spirit produces, we display His fruit.
- Fruit = love displayed in many forms.
- When you feed on the goodness of God, maturity happens. Then *madali na mag-display ng* fruit.
- Ex. Very late employee – Man’s anger does not produce righteousness. It is the goodness of God that leads people to repentance. It is better to choose to show Christ in you with the gift of the Holy Spirit than to be angry.
- **3. The Gifts of the Holy Spirit – 1 Corinthians 12:4-11**
- Manifested in each one for the profit of all.
- Do this freely *sa church, bahay, trabaho, o negosyo*. You can use this in whatever aspect of your life.
- **4. The Gift of the Pastor – Ephesians 4:7, 11-13**
- To equip the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ.
- We are God’s gift to one another. *Blessing tayo sa isa’t isa*.
- You are so loved *kaya punung-puno ka ng regalo galing sa Panginoon*.
- He made you deserving. *Nasa iyo na. Tanggapin mo at paniwalaan mo*. You are complete in Christ.
- Believe you are so gifted! You are so blessed with all gifts. You have been made rich in Christ Jesus. Exababall grace is what we have received!
