THE PROMISES OF GOD

- **2 Peter 1:1-4**
 - **V3** His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life (physical/earthly) and godliness (spiritual)
 - **V4** having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust – *Nabubulok ang mundo pero hindi ka kasama dun. Natakasan mo na* when you believed in the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - Like precious faith – *dating mga* Gentiles who believed in Jesus.
 - Us – are the proselyte Jews who turned believers of Christ.
 - So do not believe that Peter's message or gospel is entirely different from Paul's. Peter also spoke to the Gentiles, and they were also saved. *Kaya hindi magkaiba ang gospel ni Paul at ni Peter. (Acts 15:6-9) Walang pagkakaiba.*
 - There is only one gospel that Paul and Peter preached. Do not believe those who say otherwise.
- Now that we are sure *na tayo ang kausap, mga ka-precious faith*, we want to find out the good news Peter has proclaimed:
- **1. Grace and Peace to you all. Multiplied Grace and Peace.**
- It is a greeting but a powerful one.
- As we declare this to one another today, you can expect a good day today. Expect answered prayers. Expect manifestation of prayers. Expect good health. Expect good deals. Expect safety and protection. Expect peace in times of trouble. Expect Exababal Grace. Expect Abundant Provision.
- Expect all good things!
- Multiplication of grace and peace. *Paano? Makinig at makinig ng* Word of the gospel.
- Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord – The Word of the gospel is all about God and Jesus our Lord.
- *Mangyayari ang desires natin dahil alam natin gano tayo kamahal ng Diyos, gaya ng pagmamahal Niya sa Kanyang bugtong na Anak.*
- *Ang pag-ibig ng Diyos ang nagpapagana ng ating pananampalataya.* And faith is the hand that receives from grace.
- *Mga pangako ng Diyos na hindi napapako. Si Hesus ang napako pero ang mga pangako Niya ay hindi papapako.*
- *Lahat ay nasa 'yo na! Paano?* Through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue.
- *Pag hindi mo pa alam na nasa 'yo na, hindi mo mapapakinabangan.*
- Every Word of God is so important.
 - 1. has given – *naibigay na*
 - 2. all things – *lahat ng bagay*
 - 3. through the knowledge of Him
 - *Pag ito sineryoso ninyo, walang uuwing mahirap!*
 - *Walang uuwing may sakit!*
 - *Walang uuwing may problema!*
 - *Walang uuwing may kabigatan!*
 - *Lahat uuwi na victorious!*

- But you have to dive in to know everything that God has given us.
- If the Word says it, that settles it!
- Come to the point that the truth is the Word, not what you see or feel.
- Science found out that the brain is negative by default. From Google: Our brains have been hardwired to focus on the negative. Traced back to prehistoric days, primitive man had to be able to register threats to avoid danger and increase survival rates.
- But this is the world's narrative, not ours. Because we have been given the mind of Christ instead.
- The mind of Christ is *kung anong nakasulat sa Bible*.
- We choose the mind of Christ.
- God did not make us negative thinkers. The world has trained us though.
- *Gamitin natin ang kaisipan ni Kristo.*
- The Lord always wants us to be at rest. We're supposed to be children who are at rest.
- We do not have a negative or positive mind. We have the mind of Christ.
- Do not settle for positive or negative thinking. *Sa mind of Christ tayo.*
- Don't believe what the world or the enemy says *na kulang ka pa. Lahat nasa atin na, ibinigay na ng Panginoon!*
- God made things happen in your life by the preaching of the Word and by you hearing and hearing of the Word.
- *Sa Diyos, makinig ka lang ng Word.* So do not forsake the assembling of ourselves together. You need to hear the Word of God.
- *Nasa 'yo na ang lahat!!!* Because you are so loved by God and the Son Jesus our Lord.
- As Jesus is so are we. You think and walk like Jesus. You are conformed to His image.
- Example of God's promise – **Philippians 4:6-7.** *Nag-aalala ba si Jesus? Hindi!*
- *Pangako yan. Kung paniniwalaan mo,* you partake of the divine nature. You are partakers, participant of the Divine Nature.
- *Kumakatok ang takot, huwag mo lang pagbubuksan.*
- Every time you believe the promises of God, you are partaking of His divine nature.
- *Kaya huwag ka ng mag-alala, magtiwala ka sa Diyos at sa mga pangako Niya.*
- We choose the mind of Christ that is divine in nature.
- No to worry. No to fear. Believe in the Lord Jesus and trust in the living God. *Ipagkatiwala mo sa Diyos ang lahat.*
- Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of the Father and of the Son, Jesus Christ. And in this knowledge are the promises of God – exceedingly great and precious promises of God that allow you to walk in the divine nature of God.
- *Huwag kang mag-alala, tapat ang Panginoon. Wala Siyang pangako na napako. Lahat ng pangako Niya ay matutupad at natupad na sa buhay ng mga nananampalataya sa Kanya.*

***Grace and peace be multiplied to you
in the knowledge of God and of the Son, Jesus Christ.
In this knowledge are the promises of God –
exceedingly great and precious promises
that allow you to walk in His divine nature.***

Nasa 'yo na ang lahat!

Because you are so loved by God and the Son, Jesus our Lord.

So keep on hearing and hearing the Word of God.

Choose the mind of Christ that is divine in nature.
