## BOOK OF ROMANS (PART 7) – I AM AN HEIR TO THE PROMISE

- *Tayo ay tagapagmana ng pangako.* How? By faith. Faith is what overcomes the world.
- Ex. *Mga naka-experience na ng mana: Sila ang nagbayad at naghirap pero ikaw ang tumanggap.*
- *Kailangang paniwalaan mo para ma-claim mo.*
- Because of the finished work of Jesus, you don't have to wait *para ma-receive mo ang mana.*  
*Siya ay namatay at nabuhay ng muli,* and you are now ready to enjoy the inheritance to the promise.
- **Romans 4:13** – Heir of the world through the righteousness of faith.
- Simply by faith!
- The promise to be heir of the world is not through the law or obeying the law but by faith or *katuwiran ng pananampalataya.* *Matuwid ang pananampalataya.*
- If you are a believer, you have been gifted the faith of Jesus.
- We can enjoy our inheritance here on earth. *Hindi ito kamunduhan* in the negative way. It is the good of the land. Yes, *maraming* negative but the earth is filled with the goodness and glory of God. Open your eyes to them so you can enjoy it in Christ Jesus.
- We are of God; we cannot live our lives without God. Declare: “I need Christ.”
- Because of the blessing of the Lord in our lives, we can always see good things.
- Always see the good in any situation especially when you are in Christ. *Siya ang bahala sa ‘yo, hindi mo na kailangang ma-stress.*
- *Mahirap ang lahat ng bagay pag wala kang Kristo sa buhay.* Life is difficult, it is impossible without Christ in you. We need to learn to depend on the Lord, trusting in Him.
- We experience good things here on earth: Favor, good wealth, health, safety. *Kasama ‘yan sa pangako.*
- We are in the world but not of the world. Yes, we work, *pero mas marami pa tayong matatanggap mula sa biyaya ni Lord.* Only by faith!
- **Psalms 115:16** – The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord's; But the earth He has given to the children of men.
- Yes, we have every spiritual blessing, but we also get to enjoy the physical things. For life and godliness.
- Declare: “*Regalo ni Lord!*” *Paano matatanggap?* We speak what we believe.
- Our faith always lines up with the finished work of Jesus Christ. We speak the Word of Faith!
- The promise to be an heir, is to those who believe in the Lord Jesus.
- Faith is the noun, believe is the verb.
- *Manampalataya tayo.* We need strong faith. How? By looking unto Jesus not to ourselves, our weaknesses or doubts.
- Look to Jesus also means hearing and hearing the Word of Christ or the Word of God.
- Your faith rises out and you're able to receive.
- Look to Jesus means you depend on Him. I am weak but Jesus is strong.
- Do not trust in yourself when you should be trusting God.
- **Romans 4:16-25**
  - Father Abraham – he is the father of our faith.
  - God and Jesus calls things which do not exist as though they did.
  - Verse 18 – the 2nd mention of hope here refers to Jesus.

- If you believe, you become.
- What Jesus spoke, what the Word speaks about you, believe and speak it, and you become!
- God can make the impossible possible.
- There is nothing impossible with God and to those who believe in Him.
- *May hinihintay ka ba? Dadating yan!*
- Abraham did not waver but was strengthened in faith – keep on hearing and hearing the Word.
- Giving glory to God – praising and thanking Him.
- *Huwag mag-alala, magpasalamat ka sa Panginoon* while waiting. Enjoy the journey. Enjoy the ride. See the view. *Enjoy lang at huwag mainip.*
- Verse 21 – God promised because He is able to perform.
- He did the hard part, *mananampalataya ka na lang.*
- **1. Jesus’ spoken word is the origin or source.**
- *Kung may i-dedeclare man tayo, ‘yan ay ang Salita ng Diyos.*
- **2. Abraham believed in God who: Can raise the dead – dead body, dead dreams, dead end. And who speak those things which do not exist as though they did.**
- *Pwede pang mabuhay muli* because God can raise the dead.
- **3. Abraham contrary to hope, in hope believed.**
- In hope (Jesus Christ) believe.
- **4. Abraham became! It came to pass. Manifested.**
- **5. How? According to what Abraham believed what was spoken, so the same with us, descendants.**
- *Huwag tumingin sa* physical, temporary *lang ‘yan*, not eternal. (**2 Corinthians 4:18**)
- **6. Do not waver in the promise of God but be strengthened in faith, glorify God, being fully convinced that He who promised is able to perform.**
- *Para sa atin ‘to, heredero tayo. Dadating ‘yan, may tamang panahon.*
- Remembering it is all by His grace. And it is by faith we receive. Grace through faith in Christ alone.
- The just shall live by faith. Faith is our currency.
- Believe it and speak it out!
- Also, continue with the good works.
- Our faith is authored and finished by Jesus. Perfect Faith! Declare: “My faith is perfect!”
- *Kaya gamitin mo na lang.* Speak it out!
- *Huwag tayong pabaya sa ating mga sinasabi.* Learn to speak the right words according to what you have received in Christ.
- **Proverbs 18:21** – Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.
- We have the same spirit of faith with God, Jesus Christ, and Abraham.
- **2 Corinthians 4:13** – What we believe, we speak out. Speaking is the result of believing first.
- So keep on hearing the good news of the gospel. If you control what you hear, you can control what you speak. Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks.
- Say the Word of God because it is not a lie. It is the finished work of Christ.
- We are just aligning ourselves to the Word.
- The gospel of Jesus Christ which includes prosperity, good health, peace, joy, holiness, and many others.
- Mix the Word with faith.
- Confession – we confess the Word. We confess = “*homologia*” which means we speak the same word, as what the Word of God says.
- Confessing or speaking the finished work is our lifestyle.
- You speak “Jesus is my wisdom” when you have a difficult decision to make.
- You speak “I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus” when we have weaknesses or facing temptation.
- In good times or bad times, speak “Jesus is my Lord, my Good Shepherd.”
- Declare the Word over yourself.
- We walk by faith and not by sight.

- **Mark 11:21-24** – “Have faith in God. Whoever (*hindi lang si Jesus*) says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Therefore, I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.”
- Declare it! Do not be afraid.
- Let us declare: “My identity is Christ. I am holy, blameless and made righteous in Christ. I am conformed to the image of Christ. I am an heir of God and co-heir of Jesus. *Tagapagmana ako!*”
- Just keep on and enjoy the goodness of God in the land of the living!

***We are heirs to the promise.***  
***How? By faith.***  
***Heir of the world through the righteousness of faith.***  
***Our faith always lines up***  
***with the finished work of Jesus Christ.***  
***We speak the Word of Faith!***  
***We keep on hearing and hearing the Word of Christ***  
***or the Word of God***  
***and we are able to receive as our faith rises out.***  
***So do not waver, be strengthened in faith.***  
***If you believe, you become!***  
***Speak what you believe!***  
***You are an heir of God and co-heir of Jesus!***  
***Confess the finished work of Jesus***  
***and enjoy your inheritance to the promise!***  
***See the goodness of God in the land of the living!***
